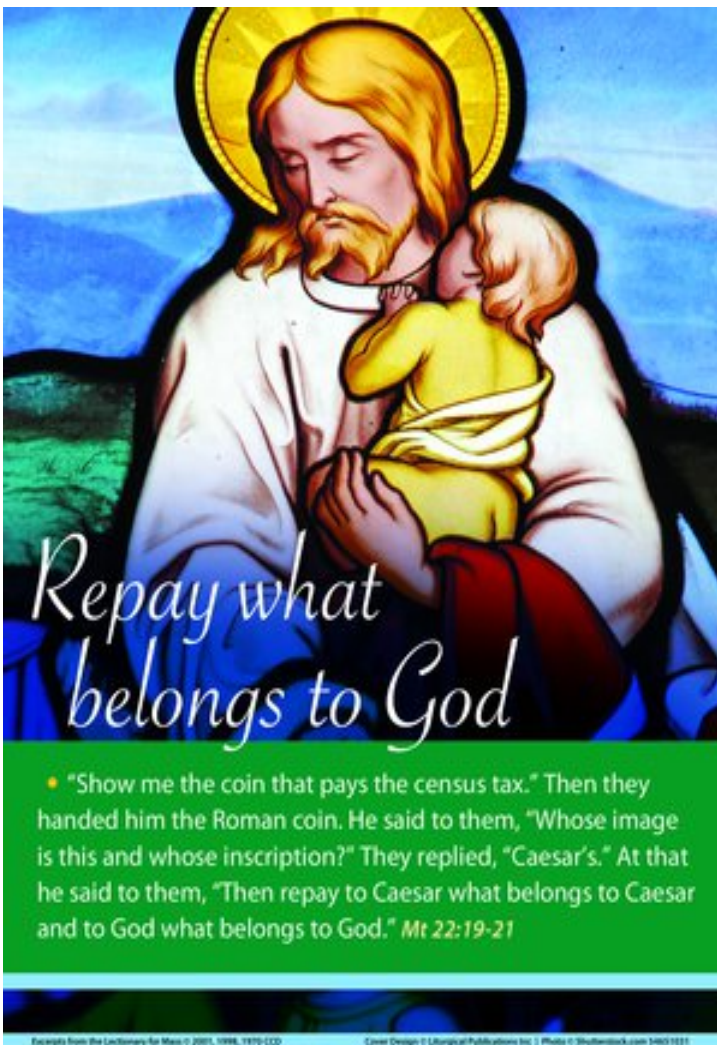

Pastor's Greeting

Sunday, October 16, 2011

On Sunday, November 27, Catholics in the United States will begin worshiping with the newly-translated texts of the third edition of the Roman Missal. What are the biggest changes in the translation of the Roman Missal that will affect the congregation? Our response to "The Lord be with you" changes from "And also with you" to "And with your spirit." There are small changes in some of the other responses, too. Returning to the word order of the Latin text has given us five more lines in the Glory to God. You will find many changes in the creeds. The Nicene Creed now reads "consubstantial with the Father" instead of "one in being with the Father." The Apostles' Creed speaks of Jesus who "descended into hell" instead of "descended to the dead." The prayer, "Lord, I am not worthy to receive you" that we pray just before communion now reads, "Lord, I am not worthy that you should enter under my roof ...". This is a good example of how a prayer now more closely reflects the biblical passage Matthew 8.8 that it echoes.

Parents and care givers who send a child off to college or to a different city to live on their own may observe that their child gradually becomes aware of who fed, clean, clothed and housed in their infant years; who sacrificed so much time, personal interest and resources to provide them with education and opportunities to grow and mature. It may not be until that child has a child of their own that they fully appreciate all their parents or care givers did for them and how much they owe them, and possibly express gratitude. If we become aware of God's gifts to us and try to use them to the best of our ability for ourselves and others, we may understand our obligation to thank God for his generosity. If we never become aware of God's gifts to us, and fail to use them, we may have to depend on Caesar [the state]. Then we may understand the wisdom of Jesus, "Then repay to Caesar what belongs to Caesar and to God what belongs to God." It may be helpful to remember that without God there would be no Caesar [the state].
